

Ask Them

You facilitate groups of people in various circumstances – training, focus groups, problem solving groups etc. and you sometimes wonder what they are really thinking – is there real consensus, what do they think, are they sure, do they have the right answer? Well now just **ASK THEM**.



ASK THEM is a unique mobile group polling system that consists of a Reply SOLO base station and up to 50 Reply WW (WorldWide) or Mini voting keypads. Unlike other interactive voting systems the **ASK THEM** does not need the use of either a computer or a base station, though it can be plugged into a TV set or a projector if one is available.

ASK THEM is a totally mobile interactive voting system where you the facilitator have the SOLO base station in your hand and the group participants each have a WW or a Mini keypad. You can move around your group asking them simple multiple choice questions that can be read off the large LCD screen and the participants then press the relevant button to send you their answer. The results are collected by the SOLO and shown as a graph on the LCD screen.



The *Trainer* might use **ASK THEM** to find out the group's current level of knowledge, then to reinforce learning points during the session and then test the group at the end of the session.

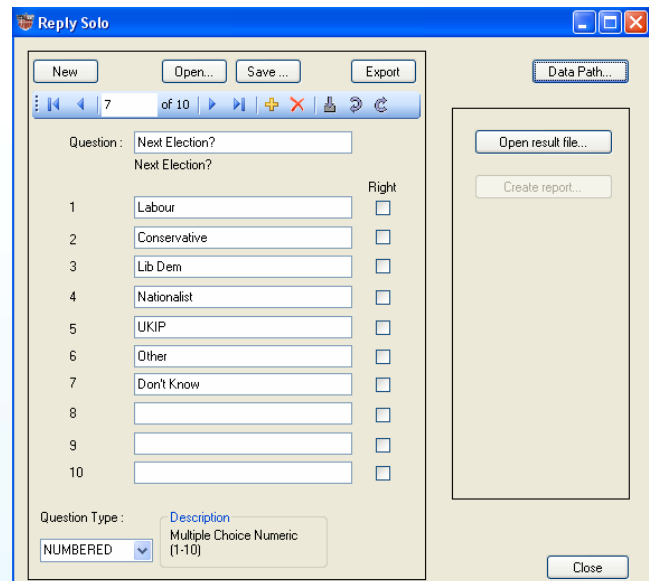
The *Facilitator* might use **ASK THEM** for quick polling on issues of contention, or to discover levels of agreement or disagreement.

The *Human Resources Manager* might use ASK THEM to carry out a quick survey of staff attitudes.

The *Market Researcher* might use ASK THEM to facilitate a focus group.

As well as coming with 10 pre-loaded generic questions, ASK THEM also has a question writing and reporting utility that allows you to programme your own questions on your computer and transfer them across to the SOLO base station using a memory stick. Stored results can then be transferred back to the reporting utility for further analysis after the session.

Questions can be asked any number of times up to a total maximum of 99 times.



The WW and Mini keypads can be used in the traditional audience polling manner using a base station, computer and projector system.
